INTRODUCTION

This Verbal Reasoning paper has three levels of increasing difficulty. Each level has 25 questions.

Check your answers and work out your percentage after completing a level.

If you can't answer to a question, leave it and move on. An important skill in Common Entrance is using your time well. You can always go back to questions you were unable to answer.

LEVEL 1: EASY

You should work through these questions quickly. The questions are designed to get you used to this type of Verbal Reasoning question.

LEVEL 2: OKAY

Most of the questions you'll get in your Common Entrance Verbal Reasoning Examination should be at this level.

LEVEL 3: THE CHALLENGE

These questions are designed to extend you Verbal Reasoning skills. You'll probably get a few questions at this level and ace your exam!





MAKE WORDS

In the questions in this activity, you need to make one new word using letters from two words. The word you make needs to be formed using the same arrangement of letters to make the new word in Group 1. Write your word in the space provided. The examples show you what to do.

EXAMPLE 1

GROUP 1	GROUP 2
mate glaze	sell tame
↓	↓
gate	

ANSWER

GROUP 1	GROUP 2
mate glaze	sell tame

REASONING

The **t** in **tell** comes from the first letter in **tame**. The **ell** in **tell** comes from the last three letters in **sell**. So **t** + **ell** = **tell**

EXAMPLE 2

GROUP 1	GROUP 2
seldom knit	badger word

ANSWER

GROUP 1	GROUP 2
seldom knit	doting snore

REASONING

The **t** in **tone** comes from the third letter in **doting**. The **o** and **n** come from the third and second letters in **word**. The **e** in **tone** comes from the last letter of **snore**. So **t** + **o** + **n** + **e** = **tone**

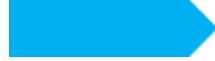

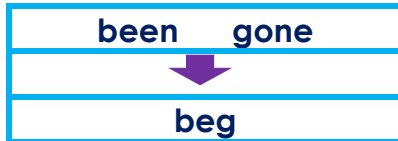

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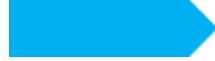
